# Elementary and Middle School Formation August 2023

Middle School youth will have opportunities for **service** experiences within and beyond formation sessions, including participating in an area middle school **rally**, to complement the formation they receive within Faith Formation.

The focus is on encouraging children and families to answer the call to discipleship with heads, hearts, and hands. Providing children and families engaging opportunities to learn more of scripture, tradition, and doctrine, while challenging them to integrate faith into their daily life.

### **Open House for all Faith Formation Families** (St Michael, Krasowski Hall) **Elementary Faith Formation, 1-5**

- "Discover" resources will be used by grades 1-5, with supporting resources for children and families.
- Folder with Activity booklets, and a *Catholic Children's Bible*, is provided for each elementary student.
- Each classroom has a set of "The Catholic Children's Bible", as well.

# First Reconciliation & First Communion Preparation (typically 2nd grade)

- Faith Formation families 'check' additional box on Form A that is required for all those in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade who wish to receive these sacraments.
- Children continue to receive ongoing formation through the Faith Formation Program or Newman Catholic Schools during their sacramental preparation.

## Middle School Faith Formation, 6-8

- Youth ministry is the way in which we invite our young people to know Jesus Christ (see sidebar on other side). Like all catechesis the intention is to "put (young) people not only in touch, but also in communion and intimacy, with Jesus Christ" (National Directory of Catechesis, par 80).
- "CONNECT!" resources by St. Mary's Press are now being used with Middle School.
  - Active and engaging lessons share the core teachings of our church in a way that helps them connect learning to living as a young disciple.
  - "Breakthrough!" bibles designed for middle school youth will also be used.
